IS IT RIGHT FOR ME?

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Nurtec® ODT (rimegepant) is a type of migraine medication that blocks a protein called calcitonin gene-related peptide (CGRP) from attaching to its receptor. This protein is believed to be one of the potential causes of migraine attacks.

Nurtec ODT is the only migraine medication of its kind that comes in an orally dissolvable tablet.*



A single dose of Nurtec® ODT (rimegepant) taken during a migraine attack:



Can provide freedom from migraine pain and symptoms* in 2 hours for some people.



Can keep migraine pain away for up to 2 days for some people.

Acute

In a study of people who took either Nurtec ODT or placebo to treat their migraines, 21% (142/669) of Nurtec ODT patients experienced pain freedom at 2 hours compared with 11% (74/682) for placebo, and 35% (235/669) experienced freedom from their most bothersome symptom (selected from light sensitivity, sound sensitivity, or nausea) at 2 hours compared with 27% (183/682) for placebo. Pain freedom was sustained in 14% (90/669) of Nurtec ODT patients through 48 hours compared with 5% (37/682) for placebo.

Call your HCP or get emergency help right away if you have swelling of the face, mouth, tongue, or throat or trouble breathing. This occurred in less 6 than 1% of patients treated with Nurtec ODT.





When taken every other day, Nurtec ODT significantly reduced monthly migraine days in people taking Nurtec ODT (4.3 fewer days) vs people taking placebo (3.5 fewer days).

Preventive

In a study of 348 people taking Nurtec ODT every other day to prevent their migraine attacks vs 347 people taking placebo, 1 in 2 people saw their moderate-to-severe migraine days reduced by at least half with Nurtec ODT compared to 2 in 5 with placebo.

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Is it right for me?

Consider your medical history

Nurtec ODT may be taken by people with stable heart disease or cardiovascular risk factors. These patients were included in clinical trials if they had no acute cardiovascular events 6 months before entering the trial.

Oral contraceptives

Some antidepressants

Preventive medications for migraine

Other acute (or "rescue") medications for migraine

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WHAT TO EXPECT



Some things to know before you start taking Nurtec® ODT (rimegepant):

- Use dry hands to peel back the foil covering of the blister pack and immediately remove one tablet.
- Do not push through the foil or store the tablet outside the blister pack for future use.
- If you take too much Nurtec ODT, go to the nearest emergency room right away.
- The maximum dose of Nurtec ODT in a 24-hour period is 75 mg. The safety of using more than 18 doses in a 30-day period has not been established.


